## **STREETSCAPE UPDATE**

The design team of Wilson Miller, Dave Johnson landscape architects are finished with final plans. Now it is in process of being approved by the City Commissioners. Brent Parker, our GGP representative, has been meeting monthly with officials. The design details, including plans for postal delivery, lighting and garbage pick-up, will be presented at the Annual Meeting. While the overall plan is complete, utility information for FPL, Verizon, Comcast, gas, city water and sewer is still being finalized.

Bids should go out in January. Construction should start in April or May and continue for 9 months. The staging plan, or how we will get around during construction, will also be presented at the Annual Meeting. The various condos will be able to buy pavers during construction and, if they want, make a side deal with the construction company to do their driveways. More details will be available at meeting or can be found at our web site.
