### **STREETSCAPING BEGINS! No Beautification Award for 2009**

As everyone living on Golden Gate Point knows, our streetscape project has finally started. For the next 9 months to a year we will be living with road construction but the results will be worth it! For the latest information be sure to attend our Annual Meeting on January 17. Because the street will be torn up most of the year, your Association has decided not to give a Beautification award for 2009. "It would just diminish the meaning of the award" commented Clark Brink, who was head of the Beautification Committee.

Work began with the laying of water mains in the "T" section and is moving clockwise through the circle about a quarter at a time. Next project will be sanitary and storm sewers.

In the mean time the landscape architect and Brent Parker, who is monitoring the project for GGP, have reviewed every tree to decide which must be taken out or replaced in a spot that will not interfere with the sidewalk or underground pipes. Although they will try to save trees whenever possible, any that have to be removed will be replaced with a similar tree in a better position. All individual associations should study plan posted on web to discover the fate of trees fronting their property and contact Brent with any questions. Updates will be posted regularly on our web site and the chance to ask questions will be available at our annual meeting on January 17.
